

Questions to Think About as Action Plan Is Developed

1. How did we come up with this plan?
2. How is this related to student achievement for *all* students, particularly in relation to our critical academic needs?
 - a. How is this related to teaching and learning?
 - b. How does this support our vision statement, the learner goals, the standards, and the Single Plan for Student Achievement?
3. What's our plan for long-term monitoring?
 - a. What data did we use to indicate that implementation of the Action Plan will improve student learning and achievement?
 - b. How will we collect and analyze the outcome measures?
 - c. What role will the schoolwide Focus Groups, Action Plan Committees, Leadership Team, departments, support staff, district office staff, students, and parents (or other groups of people connected with the school) play in the implementation and monitoring of the Action Plan?
4. Is this possible?
5. Do we care?
